CONDITIONS OF PLAY AND ENTRY

To be read in conjunction with the NHDLGA 2022 Standard Conditions of Play.

1. The District Medal Competition is a Stroke/Nett event in Divisions 1 & 2 & Stableford in Division 3, to be held between 1st March and 21st October 2022.
2. Winners of their Club District Medal qualify to play in the District Medal Playoff held in conjunction with the NHDLGA Champion of Champions Tournament.
3. Clubs may programme one mid-week & one weekend competition.
4. Clubs may host three Divisional Medals if there is a minimum of four entries in each division for both mid-week & weekend competitions.
5. Divisions are:
 - (a) Division 1 Medal – GA Handicap Plus – 20.0
 - (b) Division 2 Medal – GA Handicap 20.1 – 29.0
 - (c) Division 3 Medal – GA Handicap 29.1 – 45.4
6. If entries do not allow for 3 Divisions, two District Medals are awarded. If there is not enough entries for two divisions, only one District Medal is awarded.
7. If a player is a member of more than one club, she is eligible to enter the District Medal competition at each club. Once a player has qualified for the District Medal Playoff she is no longer eligible to enter the competition at another club. Also, a player is only eligible to win either the Mid-week or Weekend Club District Medal at the one club. She is permitted to enter both but once a player has won one of these Medals, she is not eligible to win the other.
8. Winners of the Club District Medal competition may compete for the NHDLGA Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal.
 - a. Division 1 winners (mid-week & weekend) compete for the District Gold Medal.
 - b. Division 2 winners (mid-week & weekend) compete for the District Silver Medal.

- c. Division 3 winners (mid-week & weekend) compete for the District Bronze Medal.
9. Clubs that are able to field one, two or three divisions, will have their players competing for the District Medal in the Division that applies to the GA handicap on the day of the Club qualifying round. However, at the District Medal Playoff, players will compete for the Medal that their current GA handicap qualifies them for. This may be in a different Division than the one they qualified for at Club level.
 10. Ties will be decided according to the Golf Australia count back system.
 11. A fee of \$2 per player is payable from all entrants in the Club District Medal Event. In addition, a \$20 green fee is payable for all club winners intending to compete in the finals.
 12. A player that has qualified for both the District Medal playoff & for the Champion of Champions in any division, will be playing stroke on this day. Players that have only qualified to play in the **Division 3 District Medal Playoff** will be playing stableford.

PLEASE NOTE:

Players who qualify to compete in both the District Medal & the Champion of Champions must pay their \$20 green fee on the Champion of Champions Entry Form. Only one green fee of \$20 will be required if a player is in both.
