

Beryl Tobin Trophy Conditions and Guidelines 2026

Club Requirements

Any Club who wishes to host a Beryl Tobin event MUST:

- (a) Register their entry with the NHDLGA.
- (b) The event flyer must be sent to NHDLGA for publication on the District's website.
Forward the results of their club's competition to the NHDLGA Captain no later than 14 days after the holding of the competition. It is NOT the responsibility of the NHDLGA to enquire as to the results of any competition.
- (c) Should the scheduled competition not proceed, the club must notify NHDLGA of any postponed date or cancellation.

Format

- 1. This competition is an individual Stroke/Nett event for players who are members of a club affiliated with the NHDLGA and who have a GA handicap of 18.0 or less.
- 2. The competition will be run from February to the end of October 2026.
- 3. Players will compete on their Daily Handicap at the host club for this event.
- 4. Eligible players will be awarded points in any Stroke/Nett event which has been registered and advertised as a Beryl Tobin event.
- 5. A player will qualify for points in this Trophy only if they have a GA of 18.0 or less on the day of each event & only members of the NHDLGA District clubs qualify.
- 6. Points shall be awarded as follows:

First Place: 5 points

Second Place: 4 points

Third Place: 3 points

Fourth Place: 2 points

All other eligible players will receive 1 point. The results after each round will be published on the NHDLGA website.

- 7. The count back system recommended by Golf Australia will be applied to determine place getters if needed.
- 8. At the completion of the competition year, the player with the highest number of points will be declared the winner. If there is a tie, joint winners will be declared. There will also be a prize for runner up.
- 9. NHDLGA's decision as to the winner(s) will be final.
