

Beryl Tobin Trophy Conditions and Guidelines 2024

Club Requirements

- 1. Any Club who wishes to host a Beryl Tobin event MUST:
 - (a) Register their entry with the NHDLGA.
 - (b) The event's flyer must be sent to NHDLGA for publication on the District's website.
 - (c) Undertake to forward to NHDLGA the results of their club's competition no later than 14 days after the holding of the competition.
 - (d) Should the scheduled competition not proceed, the club must notify NHDLGA of any postponed date or cancellation.

Format

- 2. This competition is an individual Stroke/Net event for players who are members of a club affiliated with the NHDLGA and who have a GA handicap of 16.0 or less.
- 3. The competition will be run from February to the end of October 2024.
- 4. Players will compete on their Daily Handicap at the host club for this event.
- 5. Eligible players will be awarded points in any Stroke/Net event which has been registered and advertised as a Beryl Tobin event.
- 6. A player will qualify for points in this Trophy **only** if they have a GA of 16.0 or less on the day of each event & only members of the NHDLGA District clubs qualify.
- 7. Points shall be awarded as follows:

First Place:	5 points
Second Place:	4 points
Third Place:	3 points
Fourth Place:	2 points

All other eligible players will receive 1 point. The results after each round will be published on the NHDLGA website.

- **8.** The Golf Australia count back system will be applied to determine place getters if needed.
- **9.** At the completion of the competition year, the player with the highest number of points will be declared the winner. If there is a tie, joint winners will be declared. There will also be a prize for runner up.
- **10.** NHDLGA's decision as to the winner(s) will be final.
