## MIXED FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP – 2026

**These Conditions of Play are to be read in conjunction with the current Golf NSW Standard Conditions of Play and the current NHDLGA Standard Conditions of Play.**

The NHDLGA Committee reserves the right to make all arrangements, to fix and/or alter starting times and to alter or make any variations to the conditions of this event. The Committee reserves the right to change the handicap limits or to alter the number of divisions in this event, or, in the case of insufficient entries, to cancel this event.

### **THE EVENT: MIXED FOURSOMES COMPETITION**

Foursomes is a Stroke event played with a partner in a team of 2 players, (one male and one female) who use only 1 ball. Partners hit off from alternate tees with the order as set out below. Once a player has teed off, the partners strike the ball alternately until the hole is completed. If either player incurs a penalty stroke, it does not alter the order of play. This includes the playing of a provisional ball.

### **ORDER OF PLAY**

Partners hit off from alternate tees in the following order: **Women** shall hit from the Red Tees **EVEN holes** and **Men** from the White Tees **ODD holes**. Tee time: Rule 6-3a will be enforced.

\*NTP's: Women 4<sup>th</sup> Hole: Div 1 – Daily H/Cap Plus - 24 Div 2 - 25 - 45

\*NTP's: Men 17<sup>th</sup> Hole: Div 1 – Daily H/Cap Plus - 12 Div 2 - 13 - 36

### **HANDICAP**

The handicap to be used is half the combined handicaps of the team. To be eligible to enter this event, handicaps are to be certified by Golf Australia. Competitors must be able to produce their GolfLink card (or equivalent) on request.

### **DISPUTES**

All disputes shall be settled by the Committee, whose decision shall be final. Any member of the Committee competing in the tournament may assist the Committee on the day and is permitted to represent the Committee or participate in the discussion or resolution of any claim, dispute or decision on the Rules of Golf within the Division in which he/she is a competitor provided the claim or dispute does not involve that Committee member.

### **PHONES**

The audible emission and/or unauthorised use (including checking or sending messages) of a mobile phone by a player or her caddie on a golf course and during play are serious breaches of etiquette and are prohibited.

### **MOTORISED TRANSPORT**

Motorised transport is permitted for this event. The Committee does not take any responsibility for the availability of carts. This is the responsibility of individual players.

### **TROPHIES**

There will be prizes for the Open Scratch, Closed Scratch, Scratch Runners Up in two Divisions, Nett Winners and Runners Up in two Divisions. Players are eligible to win only one trophy over the event with Scratch taking precedence over Nett.

### **TIES**

In the event of a tie for the Winner of the Open Scratch event, there will be a **sudden death play-off on the first hole & then the second hole repeated**, until a result is obtained. Ties for the other prizes shall be decided by the Golf Australia countback method.
