Conditions of Play

1. The rules of Golf and Belmont Golf Club local rules will govern play.
2. In the event of a tie for the Belmont Bowl, the winner will be decided by a count-back.
3. In the event of a tie for the Campbell-Jones cup a 3-hole play-off will commence. If at the end of the 3-hole playoff, scores are still equal, then a sudden death play-off will determine the winner. Play-off holes will be decided by the Belmont Ladies Match Committee.
4. Any alteration to the program is at the discretion of the Match Committee whose decision is final.
5. Motorised transport is permitted but the Ladies Match Committee takes no responsibility for the availability of carts on the day.
6. Mobile phones – as per Golf NSW Standard Conditions of Play.
7. Distance measuring devices are permitted provided they measure distance only.
8. Players enter at their own risk. On entering this event players agree that Belmont Golf Club is not liable for any personal injury however caused.
